Active Observer - attends to all aspects of the outdoor space and acts.

Provisioner - makes decisions which creates the learning potential in an outdoor space.

Mentor - model skills, learning dispositions, habits of mind, behaviour, interactions and expectations within the outdoor space.

Monitor - engages with those aspects which maintain the wellbeing of those who use the space.

Guide - influences the learning journey of the child through intentional interaction to extend or enhance learning.

Companion - interacts with the child in an encounter by respectfully building relationships.

Connector - build relationships with each other, the environment, our animal allies and the wider community.
